Changes in Year 9 Curriculum

The Year 9 Revised Secondary English Curriculum (RSEC) by the Fiji Program Support Facility (FPSF) and the Curriculum Development Unit (CDU) will be rolled out in phases in schools for Year 9 students in the 2024 academic year.

In order that all learners are assisted with reading and in particular to support reading difficulties, a special program, Special English Time (SET) will be devoted to English study. This Program will help our Year 9 students with reading, especially to those students who in particular have reading difficulties. A special program will be assigned to English studies. This will be experienced by all our Year 9 English students this year.

Role of ParentS

Three main areas where parents can rather should, contribute are:

1. Being a role model for children to follow

It is the role of a parent to teach children discipline, responsibility, and accountability by setting limits, establishing consequences and also teaching values.

2. Helping the child in schoolwork

Every child's level of understanding is different. According to the child's needs, parents can assist them by revising with them what they've learnt at school, guiding them to do their home assignments and projects (and not do it for them), helping them maintain a healthy balance of studies and play, and rewarding their progress.

3. Creating a conducive learning environment at home
