I am confident that every student has the potential to succeed. All that is needed from students are self – discipline, determination, hard-work and sacrifice. All the best for the upcoming exam.



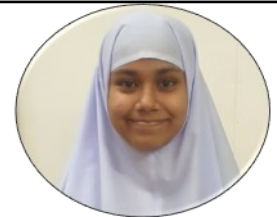
